As of the first Monday in February, all dog/cat license renewals are late and a \$10 late fee will be assessed.

FEEES: \$12 if the dog/cat has been spayed or neutered (altered)/\$15 if not spayed or neutered (altered). Renew by mail: fill out form and enclose a check or money order for the exact amount made payable to the Township of Pennsauken and mail it to Attn: Twp. Clerk's Office, 5605 N. Crescent Blvd. Pennsauken, NJ 08110. **Please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope and copies for proof of rabies inoculation.** Renew in person between 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the Township Clerk's office. State regulations consider a dog/cat's vaccination valid only if it DOES NOT expire before Nov. 1 of the current year and failure to obtain or renew a dog/cat license could result in a court summons.
